RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OUTDOOR EVENTS

Ticket holders are entitled to a refund or an exchange of tickets only if the event is canceled by our Company (hereinafter, the Company) or if the event cannot be held due to unfavorable weather conditions. It is the intention of the Company to start and continue the event even among potentially unfavorable weather conditions. For this reason, we suggest that you bring warm and waterproof items of clothing with you in case the weather may be expected to turn bad.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PARADE

A portion of the grandstands located along the route for the parade is covered (*Nagytemplomi, Nagy Lajos király téri, Egyetem sugárúti, and Fűredi úti* covered grandstands), while the rest is not (*Rózsa utcai* grandstand, *Honvéd utcai* grandstand and the grandstand next to *Kölcsey Központ*). We recommend that, on the day of the parade, you should prepare for viewing the event by checking and considering the type of grandstand you will be using and the weather forecast for the duration of the event.

Please do not use umbrellas on the grandstands during the course of the event, as they may block the view of the parade for other spectators. You might consider bringing a mackintosh with you in case of unfavorable weather conditions.

WEATHER FORECAST INFORMATION

In case of unfavorable weather conditions, the Company shall issue an announcement on the webpages www.fonixinfo.hu and www.debreceviragkarneval.hu before 8:00 p.m. of the day before the event. If no announcement is issued, it means that the Company is expecting to hold the event. However, the Company preserves the right to cancel the event even on the premises if necessary, depending on the actual weather conditions.

IN CASE OF UNFAVORABLE WEATHER CONDITIONS ON THE PREMISES

An event is officially considered completed if half of it has been accomplished at least.

In case of technical obstructions and/or unfavorable weather conditions, the management of the Company shall decide on the premises whether to postpone the beginning of the event or to continue the previously interrupted event. In case the event is canceled, the ticket holders are entitled to a refund within 5 days from the day after the canceled event on the premises of the purchase, during the opening hours of the ticket office. No refund is possible after the expiration of the deadline, as neither the ticket office on the premises of the purchase, nor any other ticket office responsible for selling tickets for the event may be forced to refund the tickets in these cases. No tickets may be refunded on the day of the event canceled.

No refund is possible if the Customer leaves the premises of the event that has been interrupted and the event is then continued and completed at a later point in time on the same day it has been scheduled for.

IN CASE OF FORCE MAJEURE: If an event, such as war, hostilities, invasion, acts of terror or foreign enemies, strikes, fires, floods, and other natural catastrophes, including energy supply shortages or embargoes or any Act of God beyond the control of the Customer or the Company prevents any of these parties to comply with their respective contractual obligations, neither the Customer nor the Company shall be considered in breach of these Rules and Regulations to the extent that performance of their respective obligations (including payment obligations) is prevented by an event of force majeure that arises.

The program schedule may be subject to change, for which reason we appreciate your patience and understanding.
